NHS treatment

From 1st April 2006 the Government has changed how NHS Dental treatment is paid for.

Patients will pay one of three charges depending on the type of treatment provided.

£15.90 for treatment including Examination and Diagnosis. If **necessary** will include X-rays, scale & polish and planning for further treatment.

£43.60 for all **necessary** treatment as above and /or fillings, root canal treatment or extractions.

£194 for all **necessary** treatment above and /or more complex treatment such as crowns, dentures or bridges.

You will pay one charge even if more than one visit is needed to complete a course of treatment.

£15.90 For urgent and out of hours treatment (further treatment after will be at one of the three bands above)

Some Important Information Relating To Dental Treatment

• Choosing How To Pay

After your teeth and mouth have been examined and a treatment plan agreed upon, you will be given an estimate of the cost.

NHS Payments :- Payment in full for the Charge Band appropriate for treatment done so far.

Private payments:- To be paid as each treatment is completed. For laboratory items half in advance and half at fit appointment.

You can pay for your treatment by Cash, Cheque (with a valid cheque guarantee card), Mastercard, VISA, Switch, Delta, or Electron.

You qualify for free NHS Dentistry if you are:

- Under 18
- Under 19 and in full time education
- Receiving Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Receiving Family Tax Credit (less than £70 deducted)
- Receiving Disabled Persons Tax Credit (less than £70 deducted)
- Are pregnant or have a child under 1 year of age

You may be entitled to help with NHS charges -- pick up a leaflet from the Reception Area or ask any of the staff for more information.

We are delighted to offer our Station House Dental Care Plans – our own membership scheme for affordable private dental care. Prices range from £3.70 per month to £13.75 per month. Full details can be found in our Station House Dental Care Plans leaflet.

Please note that the figures quoted are meant as a guide only -- a more accurate estimation can be given after a full clinical examination has been conducted and any x-rays examined by your dentist.

• Appointments & Emergencies

You can make appointments by telephone, e-mail or you can call in to make arrangements. To enable us to contact you if necessary, please check that we have both a current home and daytime phone number.

We always try to make sure that patients are seen on time. However, if you are kept waiting, there is normally a good reason. Please be patient

If for whatever reason you cannot make it to an appointment then please let the Practice know with 24 hours notice. If an appointment is cancelled with less than 24 hours notice a charge may be made.

For NHS patients further NHS treatment at the practice may be refused.

If you need to be seen urgently, telephone the Practice for advice. If treatment is essential, we will do our best to see you within 24 hours. For emergencies out of hours you should phone the emergency number.

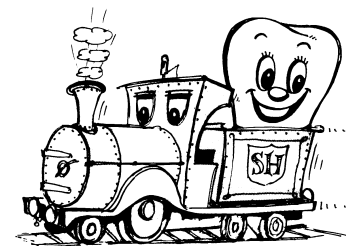
