We provide a number of different membership options to suit our patients' differing dental health. On first registration we recommend our Dental Care Membership. Your dentist will review this at your first assessment and will inform you if a different option is more appropriate for your dental health.

Safety

We take all necessary precautions to safeguard you and our staff. We follow recommended guidelines with regard to sterilisation of instruments and the use of disposable items, e.g. gloves and needles. We have a new dedicated sterilisation room in line with the current best practice guidelines. We are happy to answer any questions you may have.

Your Child's Practice Membership

Children are born free of dental disease, yet by adulthood a significant proportion of the population has active gum disease and most people have experienced some tooth decay and even tooth loss. It is our belief that disease can be prevented.

Our aim is to provide your child with the best dental care available to secure their dental health. We ask patients to bring their children with them from birth so that we can see them regularly to help them grow up free from dental disease.

Children under five attending with their parents are seen without charge. After their fifth birthday, we recommend our Children's Dental Care Membership. 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Dental Care Membership*

We have introduced our own dental membership arrangement to reward and look after our patients who visit the practice regularly. Just look at what you can gain from becoming a member!

Appointments**

Every six months, our members are entitled to:

- A 12-point dental health check, including a clinical examination, a check for signs of oral cancer and routine x-rays
- A prevention appointment to provide a scale and polish to remove hard plaque and smooth the surface of the teeth. Advice on plaque control and periodontal health. Preventive techniques to reduce decay and gum disease.

Discounts***

- 20% discount on any laboratory-based treatments required, i.e. crowns, bridges and dentures.
- 20% discount on any fillings.

Insurance****

- Worldwide Dental Trauma Insurance to protect against the cost of large unforeseen accidental damage.
- Emergency Callout Insurance should you need a dentist in an emergency, anywhere in the world.
- Redundancy protection for your monthly payments for up to 12 months.

Enhanced Dental Care Membership*

As for the Dental Care Membership, but members are entitled to two additional prevention appointments per year.

Annual Dental Care Membership*

As for the Dental Care Membership, but members are entitled to one 12-point dental health check and prevention appointment per year.

Denture Membership*

Members with full dentures are entitled to an annual examination to check the function of their dentures and ensure soft tissues are healthy, including checking for signs of oral cancer.

Members will receive 20% discount on denture repairs and new dentures, as well as receiving the same insurance benefits as patients on the Dental Care Membership.

Cancellation

We may charge a fee if you cancel your membership within 12 months of joining and/or 12 months of receiving discounted treatment.

We also offer dental memberships to include four-monthly or nine-monthly visits.

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Worldwide Dental Trauma and Emergency Callout Insurance

Emergency Callout – cover can be provided by any dentist worldwide who agrees to treat you, subject to the terms and conditions of the policy. You simply pay the emergency callout charge to the dentist concerned and collect a receipted invoice. This will then be processed through the practice for reimbursement from the insurers and you will be refunded the callout fee, minus the excess, up to the policy limits. This cover is to provide immediate pain relief only; no additional treatment fees can be claimed. You should return to the practice in normal hours for any further treatment required.

Dental Trauma – cover is provided should you be unfortunate enough to suffer a dental trauma, for example, as a result of a road traffic accident or an accident at home or at work. The insurers will settle the claim up to the policy limits and you will need to pay any relevant excess and shortfalls.

Hospitalisation – benefit is provided should you have to stay in hospital as a result of dental trauma.

Permanent Facial Disfigurement – benefit is provided should you be scarred on the neck or face as a result of the accident that also caused dental trauma, where scarring is still visible after 12 months of occurrence.

Oral Cancer – a payment will be paid upon diagnosis of oral cancer.

Redundancy Protection – premiums paid for up to one year.

How Do I Register?

Please call in at the practice where an Agreement will be completed. This will require your signature and bank account details for the Direct Debit instruction. Direct Debits are collected from your account on the 8th of every month. Benefit from cover will commence from the 1st of the month (Effective month on the dentist/patient Agreement). If you have any queries, please ask a member of staff.

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Children's Dental Care Memberships

Children under five attending with their parent(s) who are a member are seen at no charge. After their fifth birthday, they are asked to join our Children's Maintenance Membership.

Level 1 – Maintenance Membership

Level 2 - Preventive Membership

As for Level 1, but also including two appointments per year with our Oral Health Educator, to provide:

- Advice on plaque control and periodontal health
- Preventive techniques to reduce decay and gum disease.

Level 3 - Preventive Plus Membership

As for Level 1, but also including four appointments per year with our Oral Health Educator, to provide:

- Advice on plaque control and periodontal health
- Preventive techniques to reduce decay and gum disease.

Children already on any of the above plans can continue them until the age of 21, if in full-time education.

Once over 16 your dentist may advise dental health checks at up to 12-monthly intervals.

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Emergency Callout – cover can be provided by any dentist worldwide who agrees to treat your child subject to the terms and conditions of the policy. You simply pay the emergency callout charge to the dentist concerned and collect a receipted invoice. This will then be processed through the practice for reimbursement from the insurers and you will be refunded the callout fee, minus the excess, up to the policy limits. This cover is to provide immediate pain relief only; no additional or restorative treatment fees can be claimed. Your child should return to the practice in normal hours for any further treatment required.

Dental Trauma – cover is provided should your child be unfortunate enough to suffer a dental trauma, for example, as a result of a road traffic accident or an accident at home. The insurers will settle the claim up to the policy limits and you will need to pay any relevant excess and shortfalls.

Hospitalisation – benefit is provided should your child have to stay in hospital as a result of dental trauma.

Permanent Facial Disfigurement – benefit is provided should your child be scarred on the neck or face as a result of the accident that also caused dental trauma, where scarring is still visible after 12 months of occurrence.

Oral Cancer – a payment will be paid upon diagnosis of oral cancer.

Parental Redundancy Protection – plan premiums paid for up to one year.
